### **Agritabs Chlorine Tablets**

An NaDCC based disinfectant tablet especially formulated to be effective against all food poisoning bacteria, MRSA. C Difficile (2.000 ppm min.), Viruses, Algae, Fungi etc. The tablets quickly dissolve and are suitable for general purpose sanitising, deodorising and disinfecting of most non-porous hard surfaces. Each tablet releases a minimum 1,000 parts per million available chlorine per litre of water even after prolonged storage.

### General Instructions

Always mix a fresh disinfectant solution every 24 hours or if solution is visibly dirty. Warm water (not hot) will speed up the tablet dissolution time and improve disinfection.

General Sanitising of Equipment & Surfaces Add 1 tablet to 5 litres of clean tap water to provide a solution of 200ppm available chlorine. Soak or wipe & leave for 5 minutes. Rinse if required.

Foot & Mouth. Swine Vesicular & General Orders

1g per 299ml = 1 tablet in 1.0L
